<b>I am</b> I'm	I am happy. I'm happy.	Yo estoy feliz. Estoy feliz.
<b>You are</b> You're	You are happy. You're happy.	Eres feliz. Estás feliz.
<b>He is</b> He's	He is happy. He's happy.	Él está feliz. Él está feliz.
<b>She is</b> She's	She is happy. She's happy.	Ella está feliz. Ella está feliz.
<b>It is</b> It's	It is happy. It's happy.	Es feliz. Es feliz.
<b>We are</b> We're	We are happy. We're happy.	Estamos felices. Estamos felices.
<b>They are</b> They're	They are happy. They're happy.	Están contentos. Están contentos.

**Past Tense**



<b>You were</b>	You were happy.	Eras feliz.

<b>She was</b>	She was happy.	Ella estaba feliz.
<b>It was</b>	It was happy.	Fue feliz.
<b>We were</b>	We were happy.	Éramos felices.
<b>They were</b>	They were happy.	Estaban felices.

**Future Tense**

<b>I will be</b>	I will be happy.	Seré feliz.
<b>You will be</b>	You will be happy.	Serás feliz.
<b>He will be</b>	He will be happy.	Él estará feliz.
<b>She will be</b>	She will be happy.	Ella estará feliz.
<b>It will be</b>	It will be happy.	Será feliz.
<b>We will be</b>	We will be happy.	Seremos felices.
<b>They will be</b>	They will be happy.	Serán felices.


